- Size: A4
- Length: The article must be between 1000 and 1200 words and must not exceed this limit

- Format: PDF
- Font: Times New Roman font
- Font size: 12
- Margins: Normal (1")
- **PDF file size**: Not exceeding 10 MB
- The article submission must include a compulsory abstract and conclusion
- Include an abstract, conclusion, and recommendations for NEP within the article, adhering to the specified word limit.
- Total pages: Not exceeding 6 pages including abstract, graphics, and conclusion
- Participants are requested to upload their article in the specified format by logging into <u>www.nepmanthan.in</u> using their login credentials before the deadline.

- The best article will receive a cash prize
- Selected articles will be shared in journals, article-sharing portals, and peer-reviewed journals
- All participants will receive a participation certificate
